ARTIST PROJECT GRANTS APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 Go to <http://apg.azarts.gov> to create a member account. If you already have a member account, use your username and password to login.

Step 2 Create an ERC artist profile for the 2010 Artist Project Grant application process. Give your profile a name that is easy to remember and identify.

Step 3 Complete the online application. (To access the application, click ADD at the bottom of your profile.)

Step 4 Download and print the APG Signature Page at www.azarts.gov/apg. Complete, sign, and mail the Signature Page to the Arizona Commission on the Arts.

Deadlines: Application must be submitted by 03 September 2009. Signature page must be postmarked by 03 September 2009.

3. Grant Amount Requested:

4. Project Summary:

Briefly summarize your project in 20 words or less.

5. Dates of Project/Phase of Project:

Please indicate a start date and end date. Use this format: MM/DD/YYYY – MM/DD/YYYY

6. Project Narrative, Budget and Timeline, and Artist Resume/Bio

Submit the following in the indicated order with first and last name on each page. Upload no more than 3 pages, total, in PDF format.

Page 1, Project Narrative: Describe what you propose to do in no more than one page. Use 12pt, Times New Roman font and 1" margins

Page 2, Project Budget and Timeline: Outline how you plan to use the funds to complete the proposed project using no more than one page. Clearly indicate how funds would be utilized and describe the timeline.

Page 3, Artist Resume/Bio: Submit a one page resume or bio for the primary applicant and up to a half-page bio for each additional artist involved in the project. You may submit a description of training and process in lieu of a resume.

7. Artistic Work Samples:

Artistic Work Samples must represent work completed by the artist within the last 5 years. You may submit no more than one artistic work sample completed prior to the last five years, if necessary. Acceptable artistic work samples include audio, video, image file, or PDF document. Please choose the most appropriate format to represent your discipline through your artistic work sample.

Do not submit enhanced promotional materials that are different from your usual style of performances/exhibitions/programs. These materials do not allow panelists to see/hear the artistic quality of the artist. Please choose the most appropriate representation of your work when preparing your artistic work sample.

Audio Material

Audio material must be submitted in .mp3 format. Applicants submitting audio material as their primary work sample are limited to one three-minute segment. One or several short works or excerpts of works could be included. If the applicant submits more than three minutes, only the first three minutes will be heard in the jury process.

Video Material

Video material must be submitted using the provided video publisher (guidance provided at the time of uploading material). Applicants submitting video material as their primary work sample are limited to one three-minute segment. One or several short works or excerpts of works could be included. If the applicant submits more than three minutes, only the first three minutes will be viewed.

Digital Images

Images must be submitted in .jpg, .jpeg, .gif, .bmp, or .tif format. Applicants submitting images as their primary work sample are limited to five total images. If the applicant submits more than five images, only the first five will be viewed.

Written Document

Writing samples must be submitted in .pdf format. Applicants submitting writing samples as their primary work sample are limited to five total pages of material. Pages must be numbered, with 1" margins, in 12 point font size. Prose must be double-spaced, and poetry must be single-spaced.

Combination of Materials

If it is necessary to use more than one artistic work sample format, please calibrate accordingly for a 3 minute viewing or experience of the combined samples.

Artistic Work Sample Description

The online application will guide you through labeling and providing a description of your work sample(s). Be sure to include all pertinent information. Include title of the piece(s), represented artist(s), date completed or premiered, and as necessary dimensions and medium of the work, and other pertinent technical information.

8. Relevance of Artistic Work Samples:

Please state how the Artistic Work Samples you are submitting relate to your proposal in 50 words or less.

9. Other artist(s)/individual(s) or collaborator(s) named in the project and their disciplines: Use this format: Full Name, Artistic Discipline. Briefly describe the role of the collaborator in the proposed project.

10. Download and complete the Signature Page:

This page must be postmarked or delivered to ACA offices no later than 5pm, Thursday, September 03, 2009. This document certifies that at the time of submission the applicant is at least 18 years of age and a resident of Arizona and that all statements made in the application are true to the best of their knowledge and in accordance with the eligibility criteria for this program.
